

GCU Women's Volleyball Camp Code of Conduct

GCU Women's Volleyball has a strict code of conduct. This is to ensure that each participant attending the camp will have a safe and enjoyable time. Parents and participants must understand the rules associated with the code of conduct and agree to them by signing below.

Language

Each participant is expected to use clean, respectful language during the week. This includes conduct with other participants, coaches, speakers, and directors.

While on Campus at GCU

Each participant is to attend all volleyball sessions and is expected to arrive on time. Participants are not allowed to leave campus at any time unless accompanied by an adult chaperone assigned to their team, by their coach. Campers are to remain with their team and coach(es) at all times.

PLEASE BE ON TIME!

If a camper needs to leave early/arrive late for any reason, the legal parent or guardian must make arrangements with the GCU Women's Volleyball Staff. GCU Women's Volleyball is not responsible for the supervision of your athlete except in the gym and on the court.

Cell Phone Policy

We know participants want to stay in touch with family. Cell phones are permitted during the camp; however, we have the right to restrict the times they may be used. No cell phones are allowed during camp sessions. Participants may only talk on the phone during free time or other designated times. No text messaging and/or cell phone use is permitted during instruction sessions.

Laws and Standards

Participants are expected to obey every law governing our land and uphold the standards of good citizenship. This includes no illegal substances, stealing, shoplifting, or physically hurting others. Campers engaging in any of these activities will be asked to leave camp immediately with no refund and may face criminal charges.
